





Owner James Tran, whose brother has a similar business in Vietnam, hopes to earn about \$14 a pound from the first batch and hopes to raise

70,000 pounds of shrimp a year. Tran has already amassed about \$300,000

from investors and is working with consultants in Boston and the Netherlands. He hopes to entice more investors and raise another \$400,000. SKy8 Shrimp Farm has already attracted media attention from the Boston Globe, Boston Business Journal, Patriot Ledger and Fox 25, who have all trumpeted the sustainability, convenience and supply niche that this business model fills. There are currently 5 equity partner employees. Tran hopes to grow business to a commercial level, and double the firm size. 


