

Day 1 Depart USA Depart the US for Tuscany, Italy. Meals and refreshments served on board.

Day 2 Florence - Pistoia Upon arrival proceed to baggage claim. After clearing customs, you will be met by our tour director and transferred to your hotel in Pistoia. With its medieval streets and irregularly-shaped piazzas, prestigious palaces and small towerhouses, unexpected series of churches and cloisters, Pistoia is perfect for travelers who appreciate elegance and refined beauty. A welcome drink will be followed by dinner at the hotel. (D)

Day 3 Pistoia - Florence - Pistoia Today's tour will take you to Florence, a magical and magnificent city known for its art, history and culture. From the classic elegance of the Brunelleschi's Duomo and Baptistery to the magnificent Piazza della Signoria and the breathtaking city view from the famous Boboli Gardens, Florence inspires and delights at every turn. You will also visit the Accademia and see the Statue of David. Your walking tour will take you through streets and piazzas lined up with elegant Renaissance style buildings and gorgeous marble sculptures, fine leather and jewelry stores, and restaurants serving delicacies that have made the Tuscan cuisine famous worldwide. Tonight dinner will be at the hotel. (B,D)

Day 4 Pistoia - Pisa and Lucca Optional Tour Day at leisure. Today you will have the opportunity to take an optional tour of Pisa and Lucca. Gateway to the Tuscan hills, Pisa is a medieval city of architectural masterpieces, and in its heyday, one of Italy's most powerful maritime republics. Native son Galileo Galilei may be long gone, but students still come here to study at the prestigious university where he once taught. During your guided tour you will see Pisa's symbol - the Leaning Tower. Originally intended as a bell tower it's the most well-known of the buildings comprising the

Campo dei Miracoli, or Field of Miracles. Site of Galileo's gravitational experiments, the tower began to tilt even before it was finished and the angle has increased alarmingly. Elsewhere in the complex, you will visit the magnificent Cathedral, with its dark grey marble and white stone geometric patterns later imitated all over Tuscany, and the Baptistery, a perfect example of transition from the Romanesque to the Gothic style. Continue to the walled city of Lucca. Once a Roman town and birthplace of Italian composer Giacomo Puccini, Lucca is known as "the city of the hundred churches". Your guided tour will take you to the city center where well preserved Middle Age palazzos are complemented by Art Nouveau shops embellished by delicate facades. Enjoy a wine tasting at a local winery before returning to Pistoia. (B)

Day 5 Pistoia – Siena & San Gimignano Optional Tour Day at leisure. Today you will be able to take an optional tour of Siena & San Gimignano. You can spend an unforgettable day savoring the essence of Tuscany. A scenic drive through gentle rolling hills dotted with lush vineyards, green olive trees and sunflower fields, will take you to Siena, a medieval city made up of yellow-ochre buildings, terracotta rooftops and green shutters. Learn about the world's oldest bank, spectacular Duomo and Piazza del Campo, a shell shaped 12th Century square and site of the 600 year old bi-annual Palio horserace, before heading to San Gimignano. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, San Gimignano is nicknamed "the Medieval Manhattan". Of the original 72 towers that centuries ago graced its skyline, today only 13 remain. Time to roam the picturesque streets and squares, to browse the local shops and to try an award-winning gelato before heading back to Pistoia. (B)

Day 6 Pistoia – Cinque Terre Optional Tour Day at leisure. Today you will have the opportunity to take an optional tour to Cinque Terre (Five Lands), a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the best preserved natural and semi-natural parts of the Mediterranean. Hillside olive groves and vineyards perched along the coast are typical of this dramatic region where for over a thousand years people have lived cultivating the steep hillsides and fishing the blue waters. Your guided tour will explore the must-sees of the Cinque Terre from both land and sea, with a combination of easy walks, village visits, train rides and short boat trips between the villages. (B,D)

Day 7 Pistoia - Chianti - Pistoia Today's tour will be an exploration of the heart of the Chianti Classico, the oldest wine region in the world just South of Florence and North of Siena, amid a rolling carpet of lush green hills, sentinel cypress trees, ancient olive groves and sunflowers and poppy fields. After a visit of Castellina in Chianti, Radda in Chianti and Gaiole in Chianti, you will stop in Greve in Chianti for a wine tasting and visit of "Cantine di Greve". Located in an ancient wine cellar in Chianti's old town, Cantine di Greve has over 1000 labels from Tuscany alone with over 150 wines available for tasting as well as oils, "vinsanto" and salami. Here you will come to understand the complexities of the region, learn how the traditional Chianti Classico is made and how to distinguish the characteristics of the main grape variety, before returning to Pistoia for a farewell dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B,D)

Day 8 Pistoia – Rome Today you will enjoy a half day tour of Pistoia, including the main square and the Cathedral. After the tour, you will





be leaving Pistoia for Rome, the "Eternal City". The rest of the day is at leisure. Italy's renowned capital city is a constant among "top ten" lists of places to visit. Rome welcomes, embraces, and captivates travelers at every turn. Soak in the Italian culture as you stroll past Roman ruins, absorb the impressive architecture, and explore everything from Imperial temples to early-Christian churches, medieval bell towers, baroque basilicas and playful piazzas. (B)

Day 9 Rome to USA or extend your stay with an optional Rome extension Morning transfer to the airport for your return flight home.

Day 9 Rome This morning experience a very special privately guided tour of the priceless collection of art and treasures in the Sistine Chapel and Vatican Museum. Then proceed to the Piazza Venezia and Roman Forum, with a stop at the Colosseum – a testament to the greatness of Rome's past – for a guided tour. Continue your full day tour by viewing the Arch of Constantine, Circus Maximus, the Great Synagogue, Isola Tiberina and Castel Sant'Angelo. (B)

Day 10 Rome Full day at leisure. Rome is filled with monuments, fountains, antiquities and other sites worth exploring. Use this free day to stroll down the beautiful Via Condotti or the romantic Spanish Steps and to discover why Roman trattorias are famous for their fine cuisine. (B)

Day 11 Rome to USA Morning transfer to the airport for your return flight home. (B)
