

Cultural Organizations have suffered staggering losses as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic and related closures. The Cultural Organization Economic Recovery Grant Program offers grants to support Massachusetts nonprofit cultural organizations negatively impacted by the coronavirus/COVID-19 pandemic. Culture is a major contributor to economic growth and opportunity in Massachusetts, investing in the recovery of Cultural Organizations is an investment in the economic recovery of the Commonwealth. These funds were appropriated through the Commonwealth's Supplemental Budget for Fiscal Year 2020 (FY20) as well as federal monies received through the CARES Act: \$2 million from line item 1599-1232 in Section 2A of Massachusetts session law Chapter 124 of the Acts of 2020 which is funded through the federal CARES Act and an additional \$8 million from the Commonwealth's portion of federal CARES Act funding. Funds Still Available for Brockton Businesses



The Brockton Business Assistance program is designated for businesses experiencing financial hardship due to the COVID-19 pandemic. This program will aid small businesses in job creation & job retention and to maintain business continuity. Funded through the City of Brockton's COVID-19 Community Development Block Grant program and managed by Brockton Redevelopment Authority and MassHire Greater Brockton Workforce Board, Applicants may request up to \$10,000.00 for the proposed need. Applicants can utilize funds to support initiatives that will allow them to continue operating during and/or after the COVID-19 pandemic. Business Assistance Program (Free Google account is required to submit application). Visit <https://forms.gle/cmSEizk325goZKes5> for info.

The grant funding may be used for the following critical needs:

- Expenses that would not have usually occurred without the COVID-19 pandemic
- Business continuity assessment and planning
- Marketing, such as paid digital advertisements during and post COVID-19 pandemic
- General business continuity expenses
- Payroll or employee training
- Or any other applicable expenses incurred since State of Emergency declared in MA on March 10, 2020

Review of applications will begin with completed applications as of Monday, June 15, 2020. Applications will continue to be reviewed on an "as received" basis until all funds are expended or October 31, 2020, whichever is first. Disbursement of funds will start on July 1, 2020.

COVID-19 Grants for MA Small Businesses



The Commonwealth of Massachusetts has made \$50.8 million in grants available to support small businesses, microenterprises, and their employees, families and communities. Massachusetts Growth Capital Corporation (MGCC) will be administering these funds to businesses experiencing economic hardship and a loss of income due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

These funds were appropriated through the Commonwealth's Supplemental Budget for Fiscal Year 2021 (FY21) as well as the CARES Act of 2020 and are divided into two programs.

Grant funding is intended to help businesses adversely impacted by the pandemic. Preference will be given to small businesses whose owners are women, minorities, veterans, members of other underrepresented groups, who are focused on serving the Gateway Cities of Massachusetts, and those most negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Preference will also be given to applicants that have not been able to receive aid from other federal programs related to COVID-19. RAFT (Residential Assistance to Families in Transition) Program Offers \$10K Grants for Housing



(Residential Assistance to Families in Transition), provides short-term emergency financial assistance to help eligible homeowners and renters by assisting with mortgage payments, rent, utility bills, and other costs. This special program targets households facing instability as a result of a COVID-19 (Coronavirus) related housing crisis due to a loss of wages or increase in expenses (e.g., medical expenses). State Senator Michael J. Rodrigues was elected to the Massachusetts State Senate in 2010, and serves the First Bristol and Plymouth District, which includes Westport, Fall River, Freetown, Lakeville, Rochester, Somerset, and Swansea. He was appointed as Chair of the Senate Committee on Ways and Means, as well as the Vice Chair of the Senate Committee on Steering and Policy for the 2019-2020 legislative session. In the 2017-2018 session, he served as Senate Majority Whip, Chairman of the Senate Committee on Ethics, and Vice Chairman of the Senate Committee on Redistricting, and previously served as the Chair of the Joint Committee on Revenue. Prior to being elected to the Senate, Michael served 14 years in the House of Representatives, where he chaired the Committee on Commerce and Labor, the Committee on Labor and Workforce Development, and the Committee on Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure. He also served on the Committee on House Ways and Means.

Michael graduated from the University of Massachusetts-Dartmouth with a Bachelor of Science in Accounting. He is President and Treasurer of ABC Floor Covering, Westport, MA.

He is the recipient of numerous awards from a variety of local organizations. Senator Rodrigues was also distinguished by the President of Portugal in 2010 with the Medal of Prince Henry the Navigator, which is the highest honor bestowed upon non-citizens of Portugal.





